

Working Standard Lilac Satin

Proposed Working Standard for Lilac Satins

Type, Fur and Condition: To be the same as all other accepted satin varieties.

Weight: To be the same as all other accepted satin varieties.

Color: The color is to be a uniform light to medium dove gray with a pinkish tint of the entire animal and extending well down the hair shaft. A lighter dove gray undercolor is permissible close to the skin. Color is to be uniform over the entire body. Toenails are to be brown, or pigmented

Eyes: Blue gray with a ruby glow permissible.

Faults: Any animal showing a decidedly blue cast; rust coloration or patches; brownish tinge to the coat; mealiness.

Disqualifications: Ring color, white undercolor, white spot(s), scattered white hairs in excess, any other eye color than mentioned above. Any toenail that is not uniform or close in color to the color specified.
