LYNX Mini Satin

The surface color on the top and sides of the body is to be lilac mingled with fawn. The intermediary band is to be bright golden fawn over a white to dove gray undercolor. The chest is to be fawn over a dove gray lilac undercolor. The undercolor of the belly is to be dove gray. The belly surface colour is to be white or cream. Head, chest, feet and outer leg colour should match the body surface colour. The neck and jawline will be a slightly lighter colour. Eye circles and ear lacing are to be a light creamy fawn. The top of the tail is to be lilac, sparsely ticked with fawn, over a dove gray undercolor. The nape of the neck is to be fawn. Toenails are to show pigmentation. Eyes-Blue-gray, ruby cast permissible

Faults- Lacking the lilac influence in the surface color, so as to appear fawn. The lack of a distinct intermediate band.

Disqualifications from Competition - Lack of dove-gray undercolor on the belly.
